STUDENT ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITY:

Students will follow their traditional schedule and will engage face-to-face with teachers and classmates in meaningful learning experiences that also prepare them for the following day of off-campus learning.

TEACHER ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITY:

Conduct on-campus learning including preparing students for extensions of learning during off-campus days.

OFF-CAMPUS DAY



STUDENT ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITY:

Students will use this day to prepare for the next on-campus day, or as an extension of the previous on-campus day. Students will not need to log on at designated times, but rather, can work at their own pace.
